JUNIOR ENRICHMENT ACADEMY (JEA)

(BY AUDITION OR ASSESSMENT ONLY)

Junior Enrichment Academy (JEA) is for the figure skater who is interested in developing into a test and/or competitive skater. An introductory fast-track figure skating program that enables skaters to attain basic figure skating skills quickly. Skaters will learn how to jump, spin, stroke, and perform. **Must demonstrate competent skating ability and be 8 and under.** Participation in this program is by JEA Coordinator approval.

This program requires the skater to skate 2 times per week and participate in off-ice.

Beginner Starskate (BegStar)

Is an introduction to figure skating aimed at the recreational skater who is 9-12 years of age. Participation in this program is by JEA Coordinator approval.

Must pass level 6 of Canskate

This program requires the skater to skate 2 times per week and participate in off-ice.

Clothing for Junior Enrichment Academy differs greatly from that of the Canskate program. Girls are to arrive in a skating dress or skirt with their hair tied back. Boys are to wear proper skating pants. It is important that all skaters wear proper clothing to ensure versatility and flexible movement when skating. Helmets are not recommended or necessary at this level.

All skaters required to pay Skate Canada fee \$32.65 yearly (September 2015-August 2016)
