

COVID-19 ARENA PROCEDURES

VANCOUVER PARK BOARD & KILLARNEY FSC

ARRIVAL

- Skaters may enter the building 10 minutes prior to your ice time.
- Skaters must come ready with just their skates and helmet to put on.
- There will be a designated door for you to enter. It will be either the West arena entrance from the parking lot or the South arena entrance from the lane between the high school and the arena.
- Please ensure you arrive early enough time for screening questions prior to your ice time. Arena doors will be locked at the start of the ice time to ensure only the user group is allowed in.
- Dressing rooms will not be used.
- Please ensure physical distancing is practiced at all times.

ENTRANCE

- Skaters must stay in their designated dressing areas until a rink attendant lets them on the ice.
- No spectating will be allowed. All parents/guardians must leave the rink once their skater is ready to skate.

EXITING

- A maximum of 18 people will be allowed on the ice at one time.
- Parents may come in 3 minutes before the end of the ice time to help skaters remove their equipment.
- Skaters must leave the building within 5 minutes after their ice time.
- Skaters will exit out of the same doors they entered the arena through.

OTHER NOTES

- Please keep skaters home if they are unwell.
- If a skater arrives at the rink and the coaches feel they are too unwell to be there, they will be sent home.

- Stay home if you have travelled outside of Canada in the last 14 days.
- Parents/guardians may enter the building if their skater is injured.
- If your skater needs water, please ensure it is brought with them as there will be no access to water fountains.
