



BWC COVID -19 Procedures

- We are taking every precaution to ensure the safety of our staff and members, and we have new mandatory policies in place due to Covid-19. There will be no exceptions to these policies.
- We are closely monitoring the situation and kept up with the current recommendations from The World Health Organization, Health Canada, The BC Centre for Disease Control & Fraser Health.
- Mandatory “PHYSICAL DISTANCING” is in effect.
- Physical distancing of a 2m is mandatory on and off the ice. This will be strictly enforced by BWC staff and you as instructors and licensees.
- **The instructor must be approved by the Hockey Director or be on the BWC Service Provider list. (see attached for the list of approved service providers)**
- **A practice plan must be presented to the Hockey Director for approval prior to your ice session. This is mandatory to be able to go on the ice. The practice plan must always follow the BWC physical distancing procedures.**
- **Licensee/instructor must have each athlete read and sign the BWC declaration before being permitted to enter the Facility and go on the ice.**
- The Licensee/instructor is responsible for keeping physical distancing procedures set by BWC.
- Any violation to these Procedures will result in a suspension and or cancellation of your ice rental immediately. With no refund.
- All Ice times are a minimum of 1 hr. (60 min) time intervals.
- Licensee must arrive 30 min prior to their ice session to organize your group.
- The Licensee is responsible for having the athletes prepared to walk into the BWC facilities, and no earlier than 15 min before your scheduled ice time.
- Early access to BWC is not permitted. If your group is early have them wait in their cars or in the parking lot.



- You will enter BWC through the 'Players Entrance' located on the south side of our main building and exit through the double exit doors just north of the Activity Rink. (signs will be posted accordingly)
- When entering the BWC facility you must go to your designated rink. Activity, Training or NHL (signs will be posted accordingly).
- There will be designated seating, for each athlete and coach in the rink. to tie and untie your skates.
- BWC will have 1 restroom available near the dressing room area.
- BWC dressing rooms are closed and off limits.
- When your ice is booked on the NHL Rink, you will enter through the main double doors entrance, and exit through the single door on the south side of the building which is usually our home team entrance. (signs will be posted)
- NHL Rink Dressing Rooms are also closed. There will be designated seating to put your skates on and, take them off.
- Players must come to BWC fully dressed in the exception of skates; you can put your skates on in your designated sitting area.
- No common areas will be open or accessible. The main level and upstairs of BWC will be closed to everyone.
- NHL viewing area is also closed.
- Spectators are not allowed (parents or siblings) in the facility.
- Coaches are required to wear Helmets while on the ice at BWC.
- Every athlete must have their own water bottle. (no sharing)
- Spitting is strictly prohibited.
- There will be no group gatherings on the ice at any time. This includes the instruction of drills; Physical distancing is always in effect.
- Shooting, passing, skating drills are permitted.
- No battle or compete drills will be allowed.
- BWC staff will be in place to help with any questions or assistance needed.
- We are educating our staff regarding illness prevention measures; we have expanded this already thorough cleaning and sanitizing procedures.
- Our operations of Food & Beverage are closed.
- No Physical gatherings of any size are permitted in the parking lot or overflow parking lot areas. **Note:** Consuming alcohol beverages in the parking lot is in contravention of our liquor license and could result in personal fines from the RCMP/Liquor Inspector in addition to citations and harsh penalties/suspensions to the club. Tailgating is prohibited in the parking lot.



- Please note that our staff will be visible on property and understand that they will be there to help enforce the physical distancing procedures. Those not following these procedures will be escorted from the facility.
- Self-imposed limits to the number of guests allowed in our building are closely monitored and will be adjusted accordingly.
- As this situation progresses, we will continue to monitor all developments and update our policies and procedures accordingly.
- These procedures are in effect from May 6th – 31st.
- Our priority is to make sure everyone is safe and healthy. We will follow all direction from Fraser health Board and their recommendation to be able to add or delete large groups in our facility.
- All Rental Groups/Users/Licensee must adhere to all BWC rental policies.
