Hello Skaters, Parents and Coaches,

KCFSC would like to thank you all for your patience and support during this global COVID-19 Pandemic.

The safety of all our skaters, coaches, volunteers and family members is our top priority and key to planning the start of our 2020 season.

Since the stoppage in mid-March, our coaches were able to maintain the Off-Ice programing via Zoom 2 to 5 days per week for our COMP/STAR and JEA skaters. In July, the Ministry of Health, Skate Canada and BC/YK Section approved 'Return to Ice' with limited skaters per session. We were fortunate to have obtained ice at the following facilities: BWC, Planet Ice Delta, Planet Ice Coquitlam and Scotia Barn.

Moving forward to the upcoming FALL 2020 season, we are working with the City of Vancouver for a 'Return to Ice' at our home Killarney Ice Rink by September 28th. At this time, we will be continue to offer Off-Ice for COMP/STAR and JEA skaters, and On-Ice for COMP/STAR skaters for the month of September at Scotia Barn. Unfortunately, due to age restrictions at Scotia Barn, we are unable to offer JEA On-Ice sessions.
