Junior Enrichment Academy (JEA) is for the figure skater who is interested in developing into a test and/or competitive skater. An introductory fast-track figure skating program that enables skaters to attain basic figure skating skills quickly. Skaters will learn how to jump, spin, stroke, and perform. **Must demonstrate competent skating ability and be 8 and under.** Participation in this program is by JEA Coordinator approval.

This program requires the skater to skate 2 times per week and participate in off-ice.
