### **Coaches Corner**

While "a pair of skates is all it takes" we have to take care of those skates! Here are our top tips for taking care of your skates:

- Wear skate guards when walking with your skates off the ice this will protect your blades which are critical to your skating experience
- o After skating, dry your blades! It is essential to keep your skate dry moisture is your worst enemy
- Always carry your skates in a bag you don't want to risk hurting your skates or your laces
- o In your skating bag, protect with blade cover
- Once at home, remove your skates from your bag to let them dry
- Don't forget your laces! Makes sure you check your laces regularly to ensure they are in good condition and not getting too thin and always carry a spare pair of laces - just in case
